The CFPS are proud to announce a weekend tour from the North West to Cornwall. Saturday - 40145 - Crewe, Warrington Bank Quay, Manchester Victoria, Stockport, Stoke, Stafford, Birmingham International (attach D1015), Banbury, Oxford, Swindon, Bristol TM, Plymouth (D1015 to rear) to Penzance (short break). Early evening – Penzance (1940) to Truro, Falmouth, Truro, Penzance (2215). Sunday – D1015 front 40145 rear. Penzance, St Ives, Penzance, Par, Newquay (40145 lead to Newquay), Plymouth (40145 run round to front, 40145/D1015 in Tandem to Oxford via Bristol TM & Swindon as outward. 40145 solo from Oxford returning the same route as outward trip.

**Fares**

If you book BY 15<sup>th</sup> March you will qualify for a 5% discount on all tickets, The prices opposite state the fares including & excluding the discount. NO discount off the "Table for Two" Supplement.

**Timings**

All times shown are just an estimate at the moment, more details will be posted on the CFPS website when known.
